- **SUBJECT:** Instructions for the performance of the LRHS <u>Concert Band</u> at the 2019 Music Performance Adjudication (Festival) at Garner High School on Tuesday 26 Mar 19. This is the 22<sup>nd</sup> State Contest for the Concert Band!
- DRIVERS: Bus 1......Ms. Montgomery Bus 2.....Mr. Goble

CHAPERONES: Dahlresma Marks-Evans, Casey Bombien, David Price, Margret Bachand

UNIFORM: When you arrive at school, you should have your <u>CONCERT UNIFORM</u> in a <u>suit bag</u> with <u>your name on it</u>! - Black dress, <u>pearls</u> & black Leesville Character shoes for the girls; tuxedo coat, black pants, black shoes, black socks, bow tie, cummerbund, white shirt for the guys. *Please set this aside on MONDAY night as there is no time for forgetting on TUESDAY morning!!!* 

We will place these bags on racks in the Ensemble Room with your uniform in them, so, you will need to be able to identify your suit bag. You can get a suit bag from any place that sells suits. This should not be very expensive - if you need one, maybe Savi will give you one if you tell them you are in the Leesville Band! Be sure to always have ALL the Uniform on...NEVER just part of it!

- **EQUIPMENT:** We will need a list from the **percussion** section as to EVERYTHING we will be using. Instruments, Folios, etc., will be placed in the trailer after our rehearsal 2<sup>nd</sup> period. Make sure we remove all of our percussion instruments and mutes off stage and back into the trailer after the performance.....also bring extra tuners.... with good batteries.....we will need them!
- MUSIC: His Honor, Irish Tune from County Derry, Lanigan's Ball
- MONEY: <u>Please bring \$5 to Ms. Montgomery by MONDAY March 25<sup>th</sup></u> so that we can purchase pizzas to have for lunch before we leave for MPA. If you do NOT want pizza and plan to bring your own lunch, please let Ms. Montgomery know ASAP.

  - 10:50.. Leave 3<sup>rd</sup> period to return to the band room for lunch
  - 11:00.. Eat lunch in the band room.
  - 11:30.. Change into Uniforms
  - 11:55... Count-off again to make sure we have everyone, load busses AS SOON AS Ms. M gets back.
  - \*\*12:15 (or AS SOON AS POSSIBLE)... Depart for Garner High School
  - 1:00..... Arrive Garner High School, Registration, Unload
- PM 1:25.... Warm up
  - 2:05..... LHS Concert Band Stage Performance
  - 2:40..... Sight-Reading and Clinic
  - 3:40..... Load Instruments
  - 4:00..... Depart Garner High School (OR AS SOON AS POSSIBLE)
  - 4:45..... Arrive at LRHS, clean and check buses, unload, put away folios

NOTES: It is our tradition at Leesville to take competition as a serious level of performance. <u>To do this, we do not talk</u> once we arrive at Garner High School until we go back to the bus. DO NOT ASK QUESTIONS, INSTRUCTIONS WILL BE <u>GIVEN IF NEEDED.....This helps us FOCUS.....</u> Inform your rides NOT TO PARK where the buses need to load and unload! Good Luck!
