SUBJECT: Instructions for the Performance of the LHS Symphonic Band at the 2019 Music Performance Adjudication (Contest) held in Apex, NC on 21 Mar 19 at Cedar Ridge High School. This is the 25th State Contest for the Leesville Symphonic Band.

DRIVERS: Bus 1.....Ms. Montgomery
Bus 2.....Mr. Goble
Trailer...Mr. Davis

CHAPERONES: Dawn D'Bella, Jane Gress, Christine Joyner, Melinda Griengl-Schott, John Rhoades

UNIFORM: Blue Coat, White Coat Belt, White Long Sleeve Shirt that fits!.....Blue Tie, White Pants, White Pants Belt, White Socks, and White Shoes. No Cap.

EQUIPMENT: We will need a list from the **percussion** section as to **EVERYTHING** we will be using - so that we don't forget anything. Instruments will be placed in the trailer. Make sure we remove all of our percussion instruments, *mutes*, and folios off stage and back into the trailer after the performance. All other instruments will be packed as we leave. Also, please bring extra tuners.....with good batteries.....we will need them!

MUSIC: Pineapple Poll, Pale Blue on Deep, Circus Bee

MONEY: You will not need any money.

SCHEDULE: Thursday 21st of March

12:53...Students arrive for rehearsal as normal - run what is needed
1:55.....Pack-up Symphonic Instruments/Equipment and load trailer
2:18.....Normal Dismissal - students will go home to eat, and change into their uniforms
4:30.....Students arrive to LRHS Band Room in their A uniform (having already eaten dinner)
4:45.....Count-off
4:55.....Depart for Cedar Ridge High School
5:50.....Arrive at Cedar Ridge High School, register, unload
6:10.....Warm-up
6:55.....LHS Symphonic Band Stage Performance
7:35.....Sight-reading
7:55.....Load busses, equipment
8:15.....Depart for LHS
9:00.....Arrive at LHS, unload

NOTES: It is our tradition at Leesville to take competition as a serious level of performance.
