**SUBJECT:** These several pages contain General Information, Instructions, Rules, and Procedures relative to our trip to UNCG in Greensboro.

1. **TELEPHONE COMMUNICATION:** IN CASE OF EMERGENCY contact Mrs. Clark at (919) 427-2010 or Mrs. D'Bella (919) 414-0240. We are staying at Hilton Garden Inn, 4307 Big Tree Way, Greensboro, NC. The hotel phone number is 336-852-1491. You may also call this number in case of an EMERGENCY only.
2. **PERSONAL MONEY:** Students may want to bring some personal money to spend on souvenirs, etc. Frankly, we do not like for a student to carry too much! If you can't afford to lose it, don't bring it!
3. **MEALS:** All meals are included in the cost of the trip. You will be given CASH from your chaperone for dinner on Thursday and lunch on Friday. **Please bring lunch on Thursday to eat on the bus.** Bring a refillable water bottle.
4. **ROOM ASSIGNMENTS:** We do not assign rooms. The students have the privilege of choosing whom they would like to room with. There will be no changing of rooms. If we need to find you for some reason, we want to know where to find you! Chaperones will be assigned to inspect student rooms, therefore please keep your room neat and orderly.
5. **INSPECTIONS:** When we travel we always try to leave a place cleaner than we found it. This goes for Waiting Areas, Restaurants and Hotels as well. If you see something that needs to be cleaned up, do your part! Don't wait for an invitation to help out. Your rooms will be inspected each morning before you go down to breakfast...beds made up, room neat, bathroom tidy!
6. **CHAPERONES:** We COULD NOT have a Spring Trip without CHAPERONES! Those going with us are: Heather Clark, Dawn D'Bella, Karyn Anglero, John Haney, Jane Gress, Sarah Petersen, Scott Petersen, Melanie Moran, and Ms. Montgomery. We want to make their trip pleasant! It would be a terrible tragedy for one or two of our students to do something that would jeopardize all future Spring Trips.....Just DO NOT let anyone do anything.....STUPID!
7. **DISCIPLINE:** Our Band has no rules at home, on our trips, at Band Camp, or any other place we might be EXCEPT those based on COMMON SENSE and MORAL DECENCY. We EXPECT Respectful Language, Pleasant Manners, Responsible Behavior, and Exemplary Conduct from each of our students. 8. **MEDICATIONS:** Please make sure that you have shared all medical information with Ms. Montgomery that is pertinent to this trip. If parents would like Ms. Montgomery to carry their child's medication, they need to note this on the field trip form. Please communicate with her immediately about any contact information or medical information *changes*.
9. **LUGGAGE:** One small suitcase, your garment bag with uniform, one bag for belongings on the bus. Do not forget your instrument!
10. **TAG YOUR BAGGAGE:** Please securely tag your suitcase, garment bag, instrument, and backpack using the tags you were issued for Band Camp or Atlanta.
11. **IDENTIFY ALL PERSONAL BELONGINGS:** Each student should have their NAME on EVERYTHING. IF YOU CLAIM IT, THEN BE SURE YOUR NAME IS ON IT!
12. **UNIFORM:** Your uniform should be hung up and placed in your uniform bag. Full Concert Uniform: Blue Coat, White Coat Belt, White Long Sleeve Shirt that fits!....Blue Tie, White Pants, White Pants Belt, White Socks, and White Shoes.
13. **CHECK LIST FOR PERSONAL ITEMS:**

  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Portable Cell Phone Charger**
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Things to do on the bus (homework, books, cards, music, MOVIES that are AM Appropriate)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Refillable water bottle.**
