Update on Symphonic and Concert Band trip to DPAC:

The itinerary for students attending the *Oklahoma* show at DPAC on March 31 has been finalized. Students will depart LRHS for the NC Zoo in Asheboro at 8:00 am and spend the day visiting the exhibits in the North America and Africa sections of the zoo. We will arrive at Bull City Burger by 4:30 for dinner and then walk to DPAC (3 blocks) to see *Oklahoma*. More details will be sent home with those students attending in the next few days. The student fee for the field trip is approximately \$140 and includes the *Oklahoma* ticket, transportation, lunch, snack and dinner. Payment will be withdrawn from Charms accounts. If you do not have sufficient funds in Charms, please send in a check to cover the difference by Wednesday, March 23.

There are still some student tickets available. If you are interested in attending and have not yet RSVPed, please contact Ms. Montgomery, Ann Longrie (Symphonic Band - ann.longrie@icloud.com), or Leslie Mason (Concert Band - mason_leslie@yahoo.com) to see if a ticket is available for your student. Furman University Jazz Camp:

- Registration opens today and continues through the month of April. Students will perform in small and large jazz ensembles and receive instruction on improvisation, jazz history, jazz theory, and instrument-specific topics. Your students will return to school with a greater understanding of jazz theory, more refined improvisational skills, and a better sense of jazz style. We hope they'll be inspired to continue their study of this great music!
- The camp is a partnership by Furman University and the Greenville Jazz Collective. Summer Jazz Camp runs from Sunday, June 26 to Thursday, June 30, with special clinicians' concerts every night at 7:30 PM and a final student concert at 4:30 PM on June 29th. All concerts are free and open to the public. The cost is \$530 for overnight campers and \$410 for commuters per student, but the Greenville Jazz Collective is offering scholarships based on need. CANNON MUSIC CAMP IS BACK: June 25- July 16, 2022

Attending <u>Cannon Music Camp</u> held at the Hayes School of Music on the campus of **Appalachian State University** is a great way for students to connect, rejuvenate, and rekindle their excitement and passion for music, while infectiously bringing that energy back to your school music program!

- Cannon Music Camp is open to dedicated and inspired student musicians who are rising high school freshmen to rising college freshmen.
- Applications close three (3) days before the start of camp (June 22, 2022) or when quotas are reached in performing areas.

We are the premier comprehensive music camp in the Southeast. Cannon Music Camp is a magical three-week experience for students with intensive college preparatory work in performance and music theory. Plus, our campers *have fun* making music and socializing with like-minded musicians! Campers participate in daily ensemble rehearsals and music theory classes (as well as weekly masterclasses) in an atmosphere that elevates everyone's musicianship. Equally important is the direct instruction each camper receives in weekly, one-hour lessons.

We are currently <u>enrolling students</u> for this summer's season! Students may apply here: https://cannon.appstate.edu/apply Scholarships Available through March 31. We have a limited

amount of scholarship funds to distribute to individuals who want to participate in the process. <u>Scholarships</u> are awarded and reviewed until March 31st or when funds are depleted, whichever occurs first. Our average range is \$150-\$450. https://cannon.appstate.edu/scholarships

Note that submitting a performance, attending an audition site, or receiving a scholarship offer **DOES NOT SECURE** admission to Cannon. Students still need to **APPLY** through the application process to secure a space in their performance area for camp. Scholarship auditions/offers are conducted two ways:

- Submitting in a recording (see Video Submission Process https://cannon.appstate.edu/scholarships).
- Attend an onsite audition
- Receive an offer based upon selection to All-District, All-State, or Honors Ensembles

Multiple scholarship offers from Cannon Music Camp are possible; however, we regret students may take advantage of ONE OFFER, so please request to use the highest amount. Cannon Music Camp scholarship offers cannot be combined to create a larger scholarship.
