Info about this day and process:

On **Wednesday**, **September 28**, **2022**, Savvi Formalwear and parent volunteers will be **in class** to measure your student for their concert attire.

We will send home an order form (attached below) that you need to fill out and return with cash or check.

Each student must have the full standard uniform. Substitutions of other black shoes or dresses cannot be made.

Tuxedo Uniforms:

- You need to include a separate check for LRHS Bands Club for the tuxedo shoes

- Please include shoe size on the forms

- **C.** Change in Payment Method for Band Expenses: Please look for and read the important email sent to all band families on Sept. 17th, 2022 from the Charms office re the change in how to make payments into your student's band account.
- D. Fair Share Payments: Fair share payments are an important part of how the band program is funded (see Slide Show from Open House for info about this important funding). It is essential for all students to make their Fair Share payment by 9/20. Here are the details:
 - Intermediate and Concert Band Students: \$50
 - Symphonic Band Students: \$150
 - If there is more than one sibling in a family, the first sibling pays the full (higher amount if applicable) cost, and the second and subsequent siblings pay HALF their individual costs each.
 - Students in multiple bands pay only the Symphonic Band cost.
 - Please speak with Mrs. Colburn if this payment is difficult for your family.
 - As specified in the Slide show, payments can be made as follows:

A. UNC Marching Tar Heels - Honors Marching Band - Nov. 19th:

This is some info regarding the event:

"Greetings from the UNC Bands! I hope your semester is off to a great start and that you are enjoying working with your students. It is so nice to finally be back to normal, in most cases. I write to invite your students interested in Carolina and/or a college band experience to join us on November 19 for our annual Honors Marching Band. Unlike many band day experiences, our honor band is designed to be a one-on-one experience with our students. Each participating HS student is assigned to a member of the Marching Tar Heels for the day and together they will rehearse, enjoy a game day meal, perform for the team arrival, march to the stadium, perform in the stands, perform at halftime, and perform at postgame.

This event is designed as an individual experience and not a full band event. Beyond sharing the information with your students and allowing those who decide to participate access to their instrument and uniform for the game you do not have to be involved unless you want to come to the game as our guest. We ask that the students arrive and depart with a parent and we do not provide parking for buses of any sort.

We will not know game time until closer to the actual game and I realize this is the same day as the Raleigh Christmas Parade. My hope is that the two events will not overlap. For the time being, please encourage interested students to register but not pay until game time is announced. At that time they can either pay and confirm their participation or cancel."
