
PREVIOUS NEWS AND NOTES------

2. Winter Guard Clinics: Winterguard is the culmination of pageantry, artistry, and athleticism. Commonly referred to as "The Sport of the Arts", it combines aspects of dance with elements of its roots in the military that have greatly evolved over time. Students will spin flags, rifles, and sabres to a soundtrack and perform in various high school gyms, competing against other groups to best showcase their skills. Groups are either Scholastic (meaning they are associated with a school system) or Independent (no affiliation to a school required, most Independent performers are college-aged or older) and are then broken down into different classes based on skill level with the main classifications being A, Open, and World with World Class being the most advanced. Local competitive circuits will add in additional classes in order to maintain a fair competitive atmosphere. At Leesville, we compete in the Atlantic Indoor Association (AIA for short) South Division in the Scholastic A3 class. We finished our most successful season to date last year by placing 5th out of the 9 groups in our class at AIA South Championships and look forward to continuing the upward momentum that last season created. Updated Info on the Scrip/RaiseRight gift card program: Please Note: This program is a "Digital Gift Card" system. No physical cards will be supplied. Once purchased, families can access all of their gift cards in the RaiseRight app at any time. RaiseRight works similarly to the Grocery Cards. The major differences are: 1.) The cards are ordered ahead of time and delivered about 2 weeks after orders are taken. 2.) RaiseRight includes, but is not limited to, local stores. Some stores include Sears, Gap, Pottery Barn and some restaurants include Little Caesar's, Red Robin, Chili's. A complete list of stores and more details about the program can be found on the company's website at raiseright.com. Some cards are reloadable at the stores, but to get the rebate you must purchase a new one each time from the Band's Club.

Dear LRHS Band Families and Alumni,

It is hard to believe that our program is beginning its 30 th year! We are all excited to get back to our pre-covid way of enjoying band. Our musicians are back in school performing together! They are showcasing their talents at Bands Club meetings, football games, and competitions! Soon, they will be performing at their winter concerts! Seeing and hearing these kids express themselves through music is truly a joy! The LRHS bands program is alive and well because of the support we have received from our tremendous LRHS band family. Last year our Capital Campaign raised \$12,534.00 in donations! The amount raised enabled us to update the almost 30-year-old sound system in the band room. We upgraded the speakers, allowing Bluetooth capabilities, microphones for daily recording/ playback, moved the main audio hub to the band room, and updated the projector. We were also able to purchase a used bassoon. This year the goal is to replace the 30 year old Sousaphone that are needed for marching band. They have been repaired to the limit and now need to be replaced. The cost for one Sousaphone is \$12,000 and we need four! We are relying on each of you to help us continue our tradition of excellence by raising the \$48,000 we will need to meet this goal. Please consider a tax-deductible donation to support the LRHS Bands program. Donations in any amount are greatly appreciated. However, the following levels of donations will receive special recognition in all LRHS Band Concert Programs this school year. Donations must be received by December 9th to be included in the Winter Concert Program, and March 3rd to be included in the
