NEW ANNOUNCEMENTS:

1. All District Audition Information:

- Double and Triple check the Audition rules, Solo list and Scale list here: <u>https://www.ncecdba.com/high-school-auditions.html</u>

- Confirm that you are on the registered students list.
- Confirm that the correct instrument(s) is/are listed with your registration.
- For students who are doubling, confirm that you are in different audition groups (arrival times) for each instrument.
- Note that there are 3 different time columns: 1) arrival time this is when you must check in, 2) warm-up time, and 3) audition time.
- Notify Mrs. Colburn if there are doubling overlaps, missing students, or incorrect instruments. (I cannot accommodate additions at this point in the process.)
- <u>Students who arrive after their audition window has begun will NOT be allowed to audition. All students should be aware of this.</u>

The instruction sheet linked in the "Important Dates" box at the beginning of this newsletter has other important details that you will need to know regarding the audition day. Please take a few minutes to read and familiarize yourself with all the information in it so that you can be prepared for that day.

2. CB and SB Spring Trip:

• Payment #4 is due no later than Tuesday, January 10th, 2023. If you or your student participated in the luminary fundraiser or December venue fundraising, that money has

been recorded in Charms and can be put toward the January trip payment. Fruit and flowers fundraising totals will not be available in time for this trip payment.

Updated Info on the Scrip/RaiseRight gift card program: Please Note: This program is a "Digital Gift Card" system. No physical cards will be supplied. Once purchased, families can access all of their gift cards in the RaiseRight app at any time. RaiseRight works similarly to the Grocery Cards. The major differences are: 1.) The cards are

ordered ahead of time and delivered about 2 weeks after orders are taken. 2.) RaiseRight includes, but is not limited to, local stores. Some stores include Sears, Gap, Pottery Barn and some restaurants include Little Caesar's, Red Robin, Chili's. A complete list of stores and more details about the program can be found on the company's website at <u>raiseright.com</u>. Some cards are reloadable at the stores, but to get the rebate you must purchase a new one each time from the Band's Club.
