### **Fundraising Facts for 2023-2024**

Fundraising is an important part of the LRHS Bands Club. There are many ways you can participate during the year to help earn money for your student's CHARMS account, as well as for the General Bands Fund.

 Venue Fundraising – If you are interested in working at the concession stands for NC State Football, NC State Basketball, or the Hurricane Hockey games (and some other PNC Events) send an email to Craig Carson at <a href="mailto:carson.lrhs.band@gmail.com">carson.lrhs.band@gmail.com</a>. He will provide you with more details and the sign-up genius link.

This is a fantastic way to put some money into your CHARMS account to help offset costs for the Spring trips, as well as get to know other hardworking band parents.

- Families must link or re-link their Harris Teeter VIC Card each year so the Band receives money for card usage from their Together in Education (TIE) program; this can be done in the store or online - <a href="https://www.tie.harristeeter.com">www.tie.harristeeter.com</a>. Follow the steps to link the card and select 7061 LRHS Band Booster.
- Mark your calendars Bands Club Meetings Tuesday, September 19<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday, October 17<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, November 21<sup>st</sup> to hear more about Fundraising details and key events, such as Fruit & Flowers Sales, Luminaries, etc. Come learn how both you and your student can get involved and start earning money.

RaiseRight (formerly known as SCRIP) gift card program: Angela Hamilton is the coordinator for this exciting fundraising program.

RaiseRight is a "Digital gift card" system. It works similarly to grocery gift cards but there are a few major differences to highlight:

1) The digital (electronic) gift cards are accessible on the RaiseRight app; once purchased, families can access all of their gift cards in the app at any time.

**Note:** No physical cards will be supplied as they cost \$10 to be mailed.

- 2) RaiseRight includes but is not limited to, local stores such as grocery stores. Some other stores include Walmart, Kohls, Home Depot, Gap, Ulta Beauty, etc. and many restaurants including Starbucks, Domino's, Panera, Buffalo Wild Wings, etc. A complete list of stores and more details about the program can be found on the company's website at raiseright.com.
- 3) 3% of the funds raised go to the band program and 97% goes directly into your child's Charms account.

#### 2. Chaperones for Band Competitions:

Competition Season is upon us! To maintain a safe environment during competitions and to ensure students have what they need and are ready to show their best on the field we need to have chaperones! Once we arrive at the competition location, we escort the students to their respective changing areas. After they are changed, we assist with any needs they may have (lost button, forgotten item(s), need a bandaid, etc.). After warm-ups, we follow the band to their staging area. Once there and prepped, chaperones go to the stands to watch the band's performance. After the performance, we will meet again to escort the students back to their designated changing area and set up a snack. After cleaning up, we are back to the stands to watch the remaining bands and the awards ceremony. Once all is finished, we will make sure

the students are back at the buses and hit the road home. See the 4 dates below and sign up for what works best for you. We would like to have 7 chaperones (including me), with a minimum of 2 male chaperones (NOT ON PIT CREW pit crew will have their own responsibilities) for each competition.
